- What is your main takeaway from this documentary?
- Different pro-life leaders discuss their decision to stand against Mulroney's bill, which would have ensured some legal protection for preborn children. Do you agree with those who refused to support it? Explain your stance on this.
- Did this documentary make you think differently about incremental abortion laws, that is, laws that protect only some children from abortion while leaving others unprotected?
- Why do you think no government since Mulroney's has tried to introduce an abortion bill?
- What are some ways you think you can tangibly help women facing an unplanned pregnancy?
- How can we teach our children the value of life in a culture that devalues life? How can we teach them to do the right thing instead of the easy thing?
- What are some questions you can ask your local representatives to let them know this is an important issue to you as a voter?
- What is the relationship between law and public opinion? Which drives greater change?
