Feel free to use all or some of these questions to start a discussion following your screening of *The Missing Project*.

- What is your main takeaway from this documentary?
- Different pro-life leaders discuss their decision to stand against Mulroney's bill, which would have ensured some legal protection for pre-born children. Do you agree with those who refused to support it? Explain your stance on this.
- Did this documentary make you think differently about incremental abortion laws, that is, laws that protect only some children from abortion while leaving others unprotected?
- Why do you think no government since Mulroney's has tried to introduce an abortion bill?
- What are some ways you think you can tangibly help women facing an unplanned pregnancy?
- How can we teach our children the value of life in a culture that devalues life? How can we teach them to do the right thing instead of the easy thing?
- What are some questions you can ask your local representatives to let them know this is an important issue to you as a voter?
- What is the relationship between law and public opinion? Which drives greater change?
